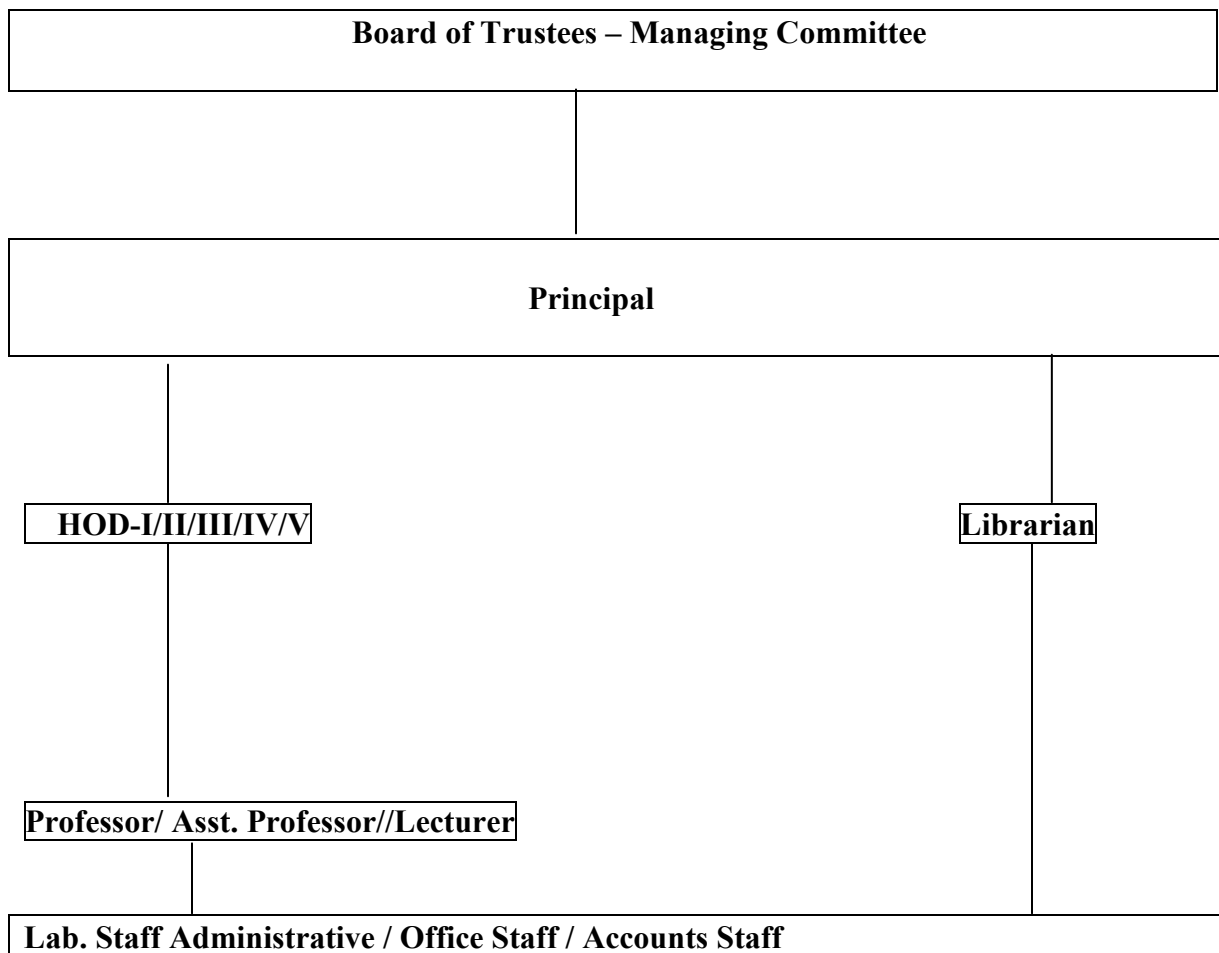

### Feedback System

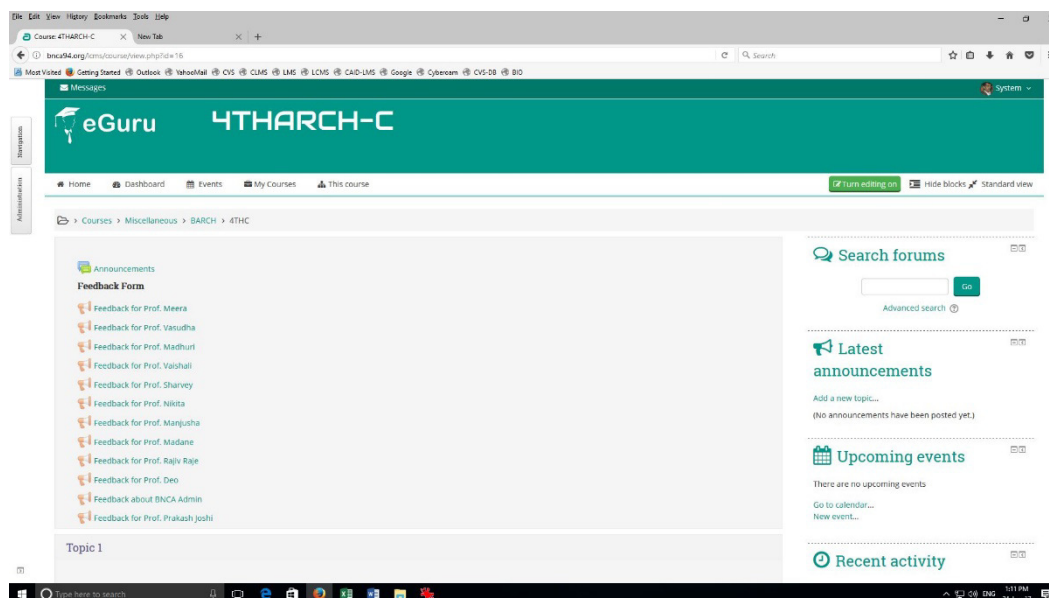
- We have deployed online Feedback/Evaluation system for betterment in teaching and learning process. Feedback from students about Teachers, teaching methods, Library, and the administration of the college.
- Which has customized question bank with suggestion box.
- All the answers are analysed automatically. The analysed output of the feedback is in the form of question and answers with a bar chart showing the analysis of each question.

This feedback is anonymous and hence the student can give genuine feedback about the teacher and or the facility.

Every student has username and password to access the system.

The user has access to the respective class.

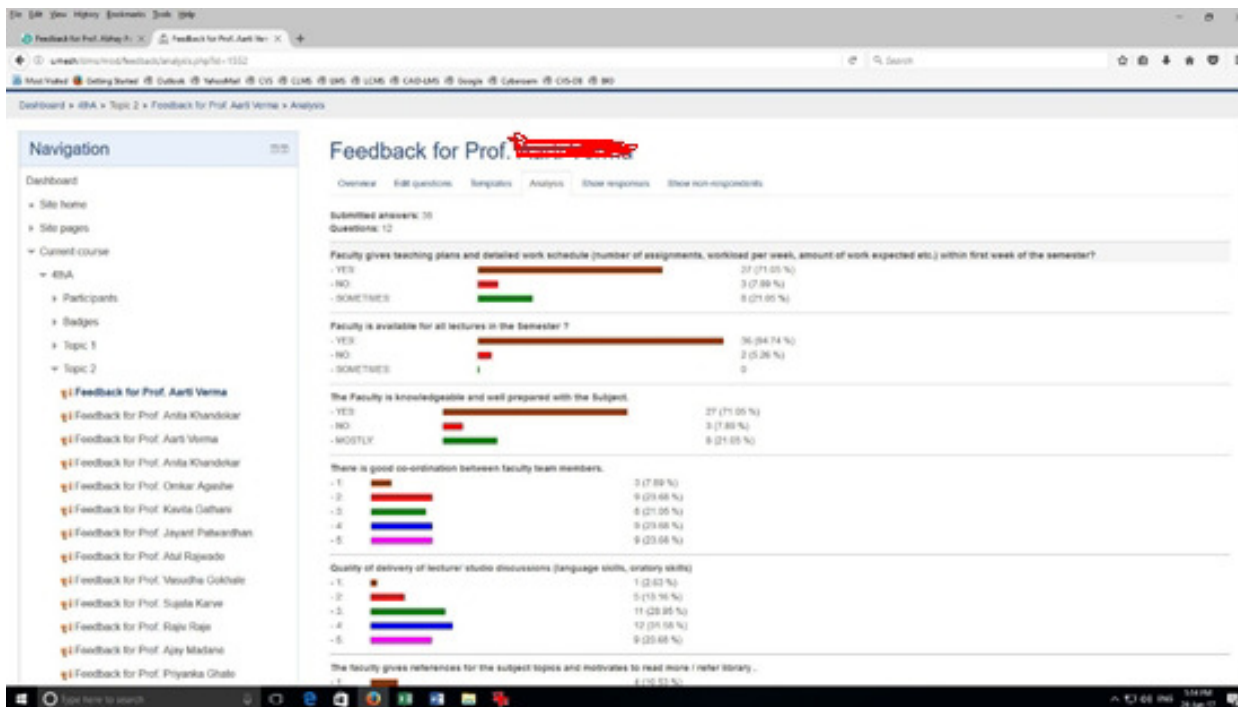
All the feedback given by the students are invisible to other students and or teachers.



The concern department head will have all the feedback analysis in the form of PDF file.

The HoD goes through the analysis and takes appropriate action/decision.

All the analysis files are kept as backup files for future reference.



## 11. Grievance redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students

Class representatives as well as representative students of each class gives feedback about the faculty, administration and facilities to the class teacher and Principal. This takes care of most of the student problems in day-to-day affairs.

In case there is a grievance that is not addressed in regular meetings the principal is informed of the same by the class teacher after interaction with class representative and students. Whenever need arises a common meeting is then held with the principal along with class teacher and class representative/ students. If required a written application is given to the principal, upon which appropriate action is taken.

We also have an academic monitoring committee which includes all the class teachers and the HOD's. This committee ensures that regular feedback is taken from the students regarding satisfactory teaching and syllabus coverage by different teachers. It ensures regularity and systematic approach from both sides, students, as well as, teachers and thus helps to improve the overall academic performance of students and thus the college.

Any grievance arising from students, staff or faculty is addressed by Academic Monitoring Committee through discussions with representatives from staff and students along with the Principal.





#### 17. Academic Sessions-

Examination system: Semester Pattern

#### B. ARCH

The B.Arch course is a 5 year – 10 semester full time course. As per the current Savitribai Phule Pune University syllabus, for F.Y.B. Arch., S.Y.B.Arch, and T.Y. B. Arch there is a credit based semester system as per the 2015 syllabus. The fourth year and final year are currently following the syllabus 2008 pattern which is not credit based. In the credit based system for the theory subjects there is in semester assessment of 30 marks and 70 marks for end semester exams. Some subjects have a sessional assessment which is allocated 50% marks for internal examiner and 50% marks for external examiner. There are some subjects which have a viva voce at the end of the semester which is conducted by an external examiner along with an internal examiner.

#### M. ARCH

M. Arch syllabus consists of 4 semesters with credit based pattern. First three semesters are with papers and fourth semester consists of research and dissertation work. The evaluation of students for the first three semesters is done for sessional work in the form of examination with internal and external assessment of 50% each. The core subject of studio is assessed as internal and external assessment through viva voce. The final dissertation is assessed by an external examiner.

**Period of declaration of results:** Within 45 days of completion of exam
