

world and the college staff and students were happy with the results. "They analysed our reports, our studles in architecture and research studies," Kashyap added.

While the college has

been declared as Asia's best educational institution, these ratings do not include colleges from China.

The college, part of Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha (MKSS), has a qualitative research centre in architecture and has 18 PhD students. Kashyap said that the college has the only digital architecture course in India. "After Beljing Olympics, it was decided that India should have a digital architecture laboratory as well as a course on the subject," he added.

The college is pariner in the programme of United Nations (UN) Academic Impact Parmers. It has made houses for poor local residents of Tanzania, Zambia and Jamaica.

"Our students and faculty members go to these countries and learn the local techniques of constructions. 




