Some of the things to consider are:

- (1) you do not have to pay tuition in Ontario, but
- (2) you do need to purchase health insurance in Ontario (in 2016–2017:C\$51 per month).
- (3) You need to figure in your flight, rent, meals, and books, as well as telephone, local transit, and entertainment costs. It will probably cost you about C\$1000 (about Rs40,000) per month, excluding airfare. In addition, you may receive a OMG stipend of C\$2500 (for 1 term) or C\$3000 (for two terms).
