#### **Towards Ecological Landscape:**

#### Landscape Architecture, Pune and its environs

Pune shares many an illustrious title. To the apt 'Queen of the Deccan' one could add 'The Capital of the Western Ghats'.

The Landscape Architecture Community of Pune is a vibrant progressive community of professionals that plays a role of ever increasing importance and a large area of influence in a rapidly urbanising world. Ecological concerns have been increasing and this community has been at the forefront, trying to understand them, address the same in their work and in the training of future landscape architects. Pune is also an important hub for the Ecological research and action. Nationally and internationally acclaimed work in the field of Ecology, Conservation, Wildlife Biology, Ecological Restoration traces its source to a number of individuals and often relatively small institutions/ NGOs of this city.
