

BNCA Policy Document for Award of Government Scholarships to Students

Introduction:

BNCA is committed to providing opportunities for students to pursue their academic goals, regardless of their financial background. To support this commitment, BNCA facilitates the award of government scholarships to eligible students. This policy outlines the criteria, procedures, and guidelines for the award of government scholarships to students at BNCA.

Scope:

This policy applies to all students enrolled in BNCA programs, including undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programs.

Types of Government Scholarships:

The following types of government scholarships are available to BNCA students:

1. Merit-cum-Means Scholarship
2. National Scholarship
3. State Government Scholarship

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for a government scholarship, students must:

1. Be an Indian citizen
2. Be enrolled in a BNCA program
3. Meet the income criteria set by the government
4. Meet the academic eligibility criteria set by the government
5. Not be in receipt of any other government scholarship
