Interaction with villagers as students worked on a live project.</li> <li>Visit stone quarry and understand the process of dressing, carving etc and document techniques in stone masonry.</li> <li>Visit and study contemporary house Padvi House in Waghawadi designed by PMA Madhushala to understand application of vernacular techniques in new buildings.</li> </ul>
